EASTER TRADITIONS

Not long after Valentine’s Day the stores began to display their Easter merchandise. Chocolate eggs, sales on clothing, marshmallow bunnies and chicks, and baskets dominate the message. Not quite as bad as Christmas, but the religious significance of Easter can be sidelined. They might be able to hijack Easter outside our homes, but in our home its important to maintain our Catholic traditions and customs.

Not to turn our backs on the chocolate bunnies or to tell you kids they’re not getting an Easter basket. On the contrary, we can use the traditions and customs of our

society which still practicing our own.

- + new Easter clothes = for the renewal of our baptism and to begin a new life with the resurrected Christ.
- + the Easter basket = it could carry messages of God in the form of painted crosses on the eggs and colorful cards.
- + candy = sharing it with others can be symbolic of the blessings we receive and are shared with others.
